Applications are invited for ONE Junior Research Fellow (JRF) for the research project on '**Mineralogical and Geochemical Study of Rock-Weathering in Humid and Tectonically Active Shillong Plateau in Parts of East Khasi Hills and Ri Bhoi Districts, Meghalaya**' funded by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MOES), Govt. of India.

Eligibility: MSc or equivalent in Geology/Applied Geology with minimum 55% marks. NET/GATE qualified candidate is preferred.
