### Press Note

The Qualifying Entrance Test (QET) for admission to the various Ph.D. programs in the University of Lucknow is scheduled to be held on November 25, 26 and 28, 2016. Applicants are directed to read the guidelines for admission and ascertain their eligibility for exemption from appearing in the QET. Candidates have to report for the test along with a printout of their application form along with the original Photo ID. Candidates who come to the test centre without these documents will not be allowed to appear in the test. Photo copy of the Photo ID will not be accepted under any circumstances. They are also required to bring black ball point pen for bubbling the OMR answer sheets. Candidates are also directed not to bring mobile phones in the campus on the day of the QET.

All the tests would be held in the old campus of Lucknow University according to the tentative schedule which is given below.

The general guidelines are given below.

- **Applicants Exempted from the Entrance Test**

- Permanent Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors having appointment on substantive posts in the Teaching departments of the University of Lucknow or a government aided college associated to the University who have completed their probation successfully with an experience of at least Two years of uninterrupted service would be considered under this category.
  - ***Teachers appointed in self finance courses and teachers belonging to those colleges which run on Self finance basis will not be exempted from the test.***
- Foreign students sponsored by the concerned embassy and having appropriate fellowship will be exempted from test, subject to the general rules framed by the Government of India from time to time and as applicable to the University with regard to the admission etc.
- Candidates who have secured grants for research such as fellowship/ scholarship/ associateship etc. from UGC (NET-JRF)/ CSIR(NET-JRF)/ GATE-MHRD Scholarship/ Teacher Fellowship/ DBT / ICMR / ICAR / DST-INSPIRE / SLET etc. or those who have been selected in government agency sponsored projects through open selection procedure after due advertisement and have research experience for a minimum period of Two years duration and have at least one publication in refereed impacted journal.
- Candidates who have successfully completed their M.Phil. from the University of Lucknow only and were earlier admitted through National level test for their M.Phil. programme.
- A permanent employee of any government department/ public sector undertaking/ R & D organization/Other University/ private industry who is sponsored as a full-time candidate by the said organization for research work with at least 5 years of service and who is relieved on study leave for a period of not less than three years for pursuing Ph.D. programme in a Department/ Institute of the University. Number of such sponsored candidates admitted per year would ordinarily be not more than one per programme.

- **Applicants who have to appear in the entrance test**

- Applicants who do not fall in the above categories will have to appear in the entrance test conducted by the University of Lucknow.
  - ***Venue for the entrance test would be the old campus of University of Lucknow for all subjects.***
  - ***No separate admit card will be issued for the entrance test. Applicants have to report to the test venue with a print out of the application form and a valid, photo ID. Candidates not having the relevant documents will not be allowed to appear for the test.***
- The applicants appearing for the Entrance Test would be required to pass the examination to be eligible for consideration for admission across all the categories. Twice the number applicants, in order of merit secured in the Entrance test, would be called for interview as per the available number of Ph.D. Vacancies subject-wise. This eligibility pertains to the level of being called for the interview only and may not guarantee admission.
- The syllabus of the Entrance Test will be the same as prescribed for the PG Programmes of the University of Lucknow.
- The Entrance test would be of 90 minute duration. There would be a single question paper of 100 marks having 100 multiple choice questions for assessing the subject proficiency and research aptitude of the candidate. ***The Entrance Test shall have the minimum qualifying marks as 50%.***
