



## CGC stalls at Abhyutthanam Report

On 14th January, 2023, Counselling and Guidance cell(CGC) in collaboration with Sanskriti set stalls to show case its multifarious functionalities and dimensions at a glimpse at Malviya Sabhagar, University of Lucknow.

CGC display stall consisted of 5 sections:

- Student's Guidance Desk involved Live Tips on CRISP "C (Confidence Building), R (Resume Making), I (Interview Skills), S (Stress Management), P (Personality Development)" and on the spot guidance to the students was given by our career expert, Col. Sanjay Tripathi. More than 45 students from various streams had taken benefit of on the spot guidance.
- 2. There was also display of two important career tools- MCMF and CDMI, recently inducted by the CGC. My Choice My Future (MCMF) is a scientific, online career guidance solution to help individuals identify the right career path in the Indian context, by assessing their personality in relation to career interests and choices. Later some students opted for counseling session. The CDMI measures the individual along eight dimensions: Decidedness, Comfort, Career Choice Anxiety, External Barrier, and Need for Career Information, Readiness, Career Salience, and Inconsistent Information. The scale has been validated through a scientific method in order to ensure its reliability and validity. Volunteers of Counselling & Gauidance Cell were Ms Mansi Gupta, Mr. Tushar Kumar. Student coordinator Sukhansh Arora, Technical coordinator Avinash Kumar, Stage management Faisal Ansari, Aisha Zaheer, Program coordinator Utkarsh Mishra.
- 3. Happy Thinking Laboratory stall consisted of Bookmarks with positive messages; pocket Bhagwad Gita, key chains with QR code for soothing music, Positive thought cards, and Mental Health first aid kit. Mindfulness Games included activities to help students to be in the present moment and channelize proper catharsis of emotions through art forms. The games included were One-Minute Prediction, Three Minute thought recording, Paint the emotion, Busting the balloon, and hold the ice. Many students as well as teachers participated and enjoyed the activities. They were feeling more relaxed, calm and light. Participants also received gifts and sweets on their successful participation.

In addition information was given about the instruments available at Happy Thinking Laboratory for good mental health. Volunteers from Happy Thinking Laboratory put posters of various research apparatus (like Reha-Com, Triple Physiological Sensor, Biofeedback, Biowell GDV Camera), kept in the laboratory.
