In a list of the top 120 government institutions of the country taken out by Education World India, UoL has placed 51 which is a huge leap compared to last years ranking at 94! Within the state, the University was able to secure the 7th place .



Applications for the Uddeepan Scheme which aims to award the best research papers published by members of the University faculty were invited in early June by the Research Cell of the University. The results of the same were announced on 25th of the same month. Faculty members who have published in internationally and nationally recognized journals and UGC CARE recognized journals were considered for the award. [Prof. Poonam Tandon from the Department of Physics has been recognized as the top performing member of the faculty with a total impact factor of 36.759 in 2018-19 and 29.255 in 2019-20 academic years.](#)


Prof. DNS Yadav has been appointed as the Director of the Faculty of Law (New Campus).
