

- Revenue mobilization strategies: tax reforms, non-tax revenues, and their effectiveness.
- Public expenditure management and its correlation with economic development.
- UPFRBM Act: State's commitment and obstacles therein.
- Role of budgetary allocation in education, health, and infrastructure development.
- Examination of Uttar Pradesh's public debt, deficit, and its sustainability.
- Debt management practices and reforms for improving fiscal health.
- How state subsidies and welfare programs impact marginalized communities.
- Fiscal decentralization and the role of local government bodies (Panchayats and Municipalities) in development.

3. Word limit for Abstract 250 words; for Full Paper 3000-5000 words.
4. Formatting: 1 Inch Margins on all sides, 1.5 Line Spacing, font 'Times New Roman,' font size 14 for Headings and 12 for main text. No footers and headers allowed.
5. The Abstract/Cover page must consist of: Title of the paper, Name(s) of Author(s), Designation, Institution, E-mail address and Mobile number of the author(s).
6. *Selected Papers will be published in Edited Book with ISBN number by a National Publisher on the payment basis (Cost of the book ranging Rs. 700-1000 per copy) and other basic publication formalities.*
