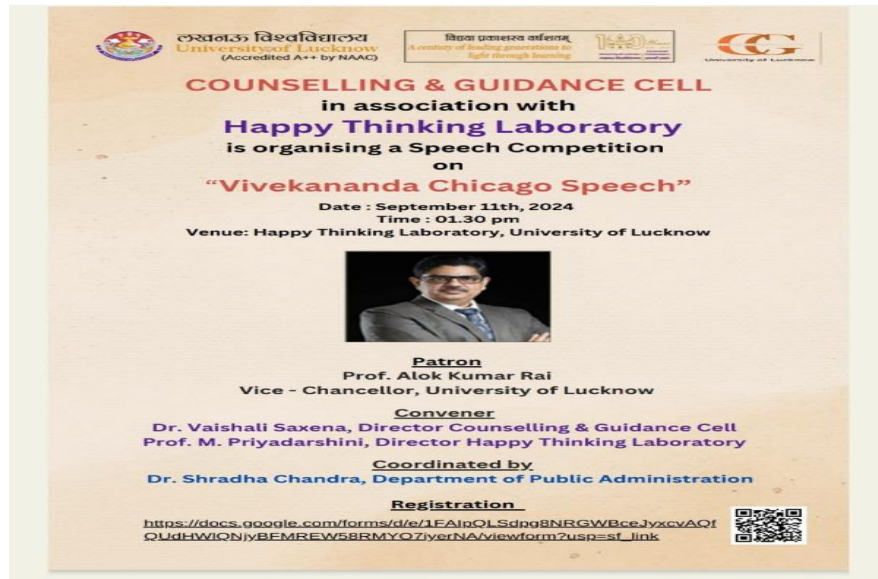


## REPORT ON “VIVEKANANDA CHICAGO SPEECH” COMPETITION
