## **TITLE: mental health of women in changing scenario**

Today, on the 16th of November, 2021, the Department of psychology, celebrated the Phase-3 of Mission Shakti. The theme of the program was mental health of women in changing scenario'.

Hon'ble Madam Dean Faculty of Arts, professor Shashi Shukla, University of Lucknow.Prof. Madhurima Lall, Convener of Mission Shakti, University of Lucknow, Dr. Varun Chhachhar Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law University of Lucknow Director, RTI Cell, University of Lucknow. Coordinator, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma Institute of Democracy, Mr. Rahul Srivastava Additional SP ATS/Social Media, Lucknow, Dr. Arpita kapoor founder and general secretary Nawal foundation, Mr. Prateek Radio Jockey Radio Mirchi were invited as Chief guests of the event.

The programme started with a Nukkad Natak performance by group students of university of Lucknow on the theme of mental health of women in present scenario.

Then a self composed poem recited by Falak sharikah followed by a short speech on mental health of Trans women by Falak and Vidushi.

Anshul Bharti recited a self composed poem on women empowerment. After this a brief speech was given by Ms Madhurima Lall, convener of Mission Shakti.

Then they have started with panel discussion.

The Keynote address was delivered by Dr Megha singh, Department of Psychology on the topic of "mental health of women in changing scenario" with the lighting of the lamp. The moderator of the panel discussion was Prof Madhurima Pradhan, Dept of Psychology.

The event started by discussing the objectives and principles of Mission Shakti elaborated on the key highlights of the Phase-3 of mission shakti followed by a brief Synopsis of the initiatives that were part of Phase-1 and Phase-2 of Mission Shakti.

Mission Shakti was launched by the Government of Uttar Pradesh in October last year with an emphasis on safety, dignity and empowerment of women and girls. It also focuses on the rights of children, sexual crime against women and girls and adoption of orphaned girls.

The programme began with the introductory remark by Prof. Madhurima Lall who briefed us about the aims of the flagship Programme initiated by the Government of Uttar Pradesh and also she speaks about evolvement of women empowerment and culture in Mission Shakti. She also discussed about the importance of mental health for women.

Then the Panel discussion was started by professor Madhurima Pradhan department of psychology with the brief introduction of Panelists. Afterwards Dr Varun Chhachhar briefly addressed the audience on the essence of mental health of women where he spoke about Right to information "No person should be deprived of right to life and liberty specially women". He also discussed about various laws in Constitution made for protection of women rights.

Then Mr. Rahul Srivastava addressed on interplay of civil factors and socioeconomic determinants of mental health, also, the effects of cyber crime on mental health of women.

After that Dr Arpita Kapoor spoke about condition of mental health of women in lower middle society and how women's are denied of education on the virtue of biological features and also she told about her initiatives for women. Then RJ Prateek spoke about empowered women by taking references from Ramayana and shared personal experience and stories about women's in his life

In the end vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Archana Shukla, Department of Psychology.

The programme came to an end with the certificate distribution to the volunteers of the program.
