
Key Highlights of the Session:


- The webinar started with the welcome address by Ms. Meghna Athwani. The chief guest of the webinar was RJ Rashi is well known for entertaining listeners in her amicable style with love and humour, Radio City's RJ Rashi, is a two-time winner of Best RJ (Non-Metro) at the ACEF Awards 2018, 2019.
- Opening remarks and introduction of the webinar was given by Prof. Rajeev Pandey, Head Department of Statistics. He highlighted the discussed points of the previous session and thanked Radio City's RJ Rashi for her benign presence in the webinar. He mentioned the objectives of the initiative 'Mission Shakti' and urged the participants to interact with the speaker of the webinar, in order to get benefited with her enlightening wisdom. Ms. Meghna Athwani gave a brief introduction of the distinguished guest.
- Prof. Madhurima Lall, the convener of Mission Shakti was also present in the webinar and she explained
 what type of problems a woman faces in her daily life and the objective of this Mission Shakti webinar
 is to make participants aware of these type of issue so they can understand and make a little step toward
 the change for good.
- The Speaker started by putting emphasis on being hopeful and optimistic throughout one's life. Life can never be a bed of roses, distress comes, difficult times come but one should have a hopeful and positive outlook. She shared her life experiences about a case of rural part where a lady was going through the domestic violence and how she and her team helped her. She told us that is working in this field from where she can reach bulk of people and make a little change in mindset of people regarding the Trafficking of women.
- She urged the participants to rise above domestic violence. The only way to break the cycle of domestic violence is to act. Start by telling someone about the abuse he might be any friend or any loved one, health care provider or other close contact. At first the victim might find it hard to talk about it. But the victim should understand that she is not alone and there are people who might help them. There are

several initiatives taken by the UP Government, but for the change on the ground level we have to change the mindsets of our children in order to ensure that they might not go through the same traumas through which the previous generation went.


- She also talk about how the family environment should be, where male and female have equal responsibilities, there is no difference of job of women and men in a family and each male person have to respect the dedication of women in his family. There is a long discussion between the participants and the speaker regarding the mindset of men about role of women in or out-side the house.




