GENERAL RULES FOR COMPETITION:

- All the participant(s) are requested to get Authority Letter or No Objection Certificate from their respective principal/head of the Institution, which should enlist the names of all the participants who have been selected to represent their respective college/Institute in the Inter-collegiate festival.
- It is compulsory for all the participants to get their College Identity Cards/ ID proofs. The participants have to wear the I.D cards provided by the University during the competitions.
- Participants are expected to carry their own properties/materials which they intend to use in their respective acts/competitions.
- Each college/ Institution has to provide the name of contact person with mobile and email for further communication.
- Participant(s) of all the competition(s) are requested to reach 45 minutes earlier to the venue of their competition(s).
- The results of the competition(s) declared by the panel of Judges would be final.
- No registration or any fee shall be charged from the participant(s)

SPECIAL EVENT

Stand-Up Comedy

Rules:

- 1. It is an individual competition limited to one participant per College/ Institute.
- 2. Act maybe in either Hindi or English language.
- 3. Time limit is 4-5 Minutes.
- 4. Participants will be judged on the basis of content, fluency, spontaneity, presentation & sense of humor.
- 5. Theme for the act is 'College Life' (friends, exams, backbenchers, canteen and related topics)
- 6. No participant can point out any individual or religion in any way, and any dual meaning obscene content is strictly not allowed.
- 7. Negative marking for exceeding time limit. Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Self Poetry Recitation (Hindi/English)-

One participant from each college/Institution.

The poem must be an original composition, else shall be disqualified. Time allotted to each participant to recite his/her composition is 2-3 minutes. Marks shall be deducted on exceeding the time limit. The participants shall be judged on the basis of-

Originality of composition

Expression

Memory

Time limit

Indian Classical Instrumental (Solo) -

One participant from each college/Institution.

Duration of performance 3 minutes.

Time for stage/Instruments setting is maximum 2 minutes.

Participants must bring their own instruments

Judgment will be based on the qualities like taal, selection
of raga, composition
general impression.

Indian Solo Singing Competition -

1.Category A: Classical Song

2. Category B: Folk Song

College/ Institute can send 1 participant in each category.

Time allotted for each performance is 3minutes.

The participants will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.

The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.

Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.

The decision of Judges will be final and binding.

Rangoli-

A team of 3 to 5 students from each college/Institution.

Duration of the Rangoli competition is 1:00 hrs.

Team have to bring their own materials.

Theme(s) of the Rangoli will be announced on the spot.

Sketch Competition -

One participant from each college/institution.

Duration of the Sketch is 01:30 hrs.

Participant have to bring own material except paper.

Theme to be announced on the spot.

Face Painting:

It is a team event. There can be only 2 participants in a team. One team from each college.

Each team will be given 1 hour to complete their painting. Participants should bring their own colors, brushes etc. Topic will be given on the spot.

Participants will be judged on the basis of creativity, innovation and design

Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Poster Making Competition -

One participant from each college/Institution.

Duration of the Poster Making is 01:30 hrs.

Participant have to bring own material except paper.

Theme to be announced on the spot.

Best Out of Waste-

The participants should bring their own material and make the model on spot in 01:00 hr on the days of competetion. Each college can send 2 participants.

Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second-hand items that otherwise would be thrown away. The material would be rejected if not found to be a waste product.

Participants will be judged on Creativity, Utilization of Resources, Artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, Utility of the Product and Overall presentation.

No mobile or Internet means would be allowed to use at the time of Competition. The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

Creative Writing Competition -

One participant from each college/Institution.

Duration of the writing is 1 hrs.

Participant has to bring his own materials except paper.

Topic (s) to be announced on the spot.

Collage Making Competition -

One participant from each college/Institution.

Duration of the collage is 01:30 hrs.

Participants have to bring their own material.

Sheet will be provided.

Broad areas: Politics, Woman, Information Technology.

Specific themes(s) to be announced on the spot.

Use of scissors, blades, scales, etc. not allowed.

Quiz Competition-

It will be a team event.

Each team will have 2 participants. One team from each college.

There will be multiple rounds in the quiz.

Rules related with each round will be conveyed at the time of

Event. Team scoring the highest score will be declared as the winner.

Any participant who is found cheating will be disqualified along with his team.

Debate (English/Hindi) -

Maximum one team allowed from each College/Institute.

Each team will comprise of two members (one FOR THE MOTION and one FORAGAINST THE MOTION).

Topic for the Debate:

English: Non- G20 and Economic Development is at the cost of Envormental Sustainability

Hindi: जो 20 और आर्थिक विकास पर्यावरणाय मुधारत का कामत पर ह

Time allotted to each participant will be 3+1 minutes (3 minutes for speech and 1 for refutations).

The warning bell will ring at the end of 2.30 min and the final bell will ring at the end of 3 min. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.

The participants will be judged on the basis of-

Content

Clarity of speech

Language

Expression

Refutation

Solo Dancing Competetion-

- 1. Category A: Classical Dance
- 2. Category B: Folk Dance

College/ Institute can send 1 participant in each category.

Time limit is 3-5 minutes.

The participants will be judged on their costumes, visual presentation and dance form.

Participants should get their own props.

Choice of song is open to the participants.

Any obscene/offensive music/song is not allowed. The decision of Judges will be final and binding.

Group Dance Competition -

1 Team from each college/Institution. Maximum of 6 members are allowed in a team.

Team can choose any ONE of the Indian Classical Dance forms to perform. Time duration for each performance is a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes.

Choice of songs is open to the participants. Participants can carry their own props.

Any obscene/offensive music/song and gestures is not allowed.

The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formation, synchronization, expressions, and costumes, makeup, setup and overall effects. Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Participants will be marked on the basis of the following for dance-

- Expression
- *Costume
- Clarity of mudras and postures
- Choreography
- *Choice of music
- •Coordination

Mono Acting -

One participant from each college/Institution Duration: 5 minutes for each participant.

Language of act should be Hindi / English only. There are no restrictions on the theme.

Use of obscene words will lead to disqualification.

Costumes and props can be used as per the act (these have to be arranged by the participants).

Decisions given by judges will be final.

The participants shall be judged on the basis of-

- Content & script
- Dialogue delivery
- Acting & expression
- Voice modulation
