The university encourages the use of energy-efficient LED lighting across academic buildings, hostels, and administrative offices. Solar panels have been installed on selected buildings to supplement electricity requirements through renewable energy. Regular energy audits help identify areas of excessive consumption and guide corrective measures. The campus promotes switching off lights, fans, and electronic devices when not in use, and encourages natural lighting and ventilation in buildings. Awareness programs and campaigns are also conducted to sensitize students and staff about energy conservation and environmentally responsible behavior.
