Singh, academic and esteemed author on 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 from 01:00 pm at Happy Thinking Laboratory, ONGC Building, University of Lucknow. The Guests were welcomed by the Director HTL, Prof. M Priyadarshini followed by the lighting of the lamp. The guests were introduced by the Director followed by an introduction of the audience. The event was attended by Prof. Archana Tewari, Department of Western History, Dr. Aparna Godbole, Department of Education, Dr. Mamta Tiwari, Department of Hindi and faculty members of the Department of English.

Prof. Singh in his address discussed the concept of Ram as the collective conscious of India. He said that the “Ram Naam” continues to be in existence since the past 17 lakh years. He proposed nice models to look at “Ram”- the managerial model, the communicative model, the political and diplomatic model, the model of “Ram” in the field of cultural diplomacy, the spiritual and philosophical model, the linguistic model, the ecological model, the model of social engineering and the education model. He also proposed various research topics related to Ram.

Prof. Priyadarshini, Director HTL said that for Ram the way of sahej Bhakti is the best and the distinguishing marks of his character include his humility, his ability and his discipline. The HOD, Department of Hindi, Prof, Rashmi Kumar quoted Knox's observation that “even a labour from India is cultured due to Ram”. Faizal a student shared some personal anecdotes and recited some compositions from Ramayan. Prof. M. Pradhan and Dr. Vaishali Saxena also shared their experience of the session with the audience.
