University Of Lucknow or Lucknow University (later referred as LU) is a government owned Indian research university based in Lucknow. LU's old campus is located at Badshah Nagar, University Road area of the city with a new campus at Jankipuram. Founded in 1867, LU is one of the oldest government owned institutions of Indian higher education. University aims to develop human resource for furtherance of knowledge through teaching, research and innovation and ranked amongst the top educational institutions of the world for the better service to the humanity in general and our nation in particular. With the same mission, University has initiated a certain diploma and certificate courses to provide formal education and training in field of wildlife and biodiversity conservation in 2017.

BRC was founded as a platform for ongoing research on Indian Lepidoptera and for the entomological collection of the late Fred Smetacek Sr., which was started as a private hobby in 1947. Today, the Smetacek collection is the fourth largest collection of Lepidoptera in India, after the three National Collections. It contains over 200 type specimens and 2500 species. Its conducts part of its activities under the Butterfly Research Trust, also headquartered at Jones, Estate, PO Bhimtal, Uttarakhand.

PURPOSE OF THIS MOU:


To establish a mutually beneficial partnership among the Parties to coordinate the delivery of National educational and conservational programs to optimize the benefits of National support in conservation of biodiversity and wildlife, to skilled students in wildlife conservation and to make capacity building in the field of wildlife and biodiversity conservation.


GOALS:

This Partnership will plan and execute mutually beneficial programs, projects, activities, and strategies to: preserve, enhance, or protect habitat, biodiversity and wildlife and reduce, prevent, or eliminate constraint in conservation and protection of wildlife.


Both LU and Butterfly Research Trust (BRT), Bhimtal are desirous to collaborate and support the PG Diploma and certificates programs to be conducted at University of Lucknow as per the discussion of Institute for Wildlife Sciences Course Coordinator, Butterfly Research Trust (BRT), Director. Under the same both parties agrees as follows:

1) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) will provide technical inputs in course design, implementation (reading materials, classroom and outdoor teaching) and evaluation of the same if required or if asked for.

- 2) To achieve the above clause, Experts (Field Experts, Biologists, Education specialists,) from Butterfly Research Trust (BRT), may participate in the course as guest faculty and attend the planning meetings.
- 3) While minimizing the cost, Butterfly Research Trust (BRT), will help LU to source external Indian and International faculties to teach in the program as per the need and mutual discussion.
- 4) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) will assist LU to develop multi-faceted panel of expert to advise to enhance the quality of the proposed courses.
- 5) The course students can access the Butterfly Research Trust (BRT, Program office and other project sites) and research equipment under this collaboration for the said purpose.
- 6) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) will assist popularizing the course through its network members across the globe and within the country using its official social media pages.
- 7) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) will help LU in sourcing state-of-art equipment's and materials (monitoring equipment's etc.).
- 8) LU shall or help to Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) experts or person nominated by them to access lab and instruments facilities available at institute for Wildlife Sciences LU for personal use on payment basis. In case for the purpose of institute consumes no charges will be leveled.
- 9) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) can take an adequate number of students for the internship/ project/ course work as per mutual discussion case to case basis. However, both the parties are agreed that students selected by Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) for project under internship should has his/her own insurance. The LU or Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) will not be responsible any risk or mis-happening during the course.
- 10) LU will organise all the necessary authorisations/ approval from competent authorities to carry out described projects, camps and expeditions. However, Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) can endorse and assist the same in capacity of a partner.
- 11) Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) can assist in setting up a placement/ campus interview for graduated / certified candidates.
- 12) LU will acknowledge Butterfly Research Trust (BRT) as a course partner and give due credit in any scientific, popular material or display signs arise under this collaboration through using its logo.




Time Frame: This Memorandum of Understanding is valid for 3 years from the date of signing.

NON-FUND OBLIGATING DOCUMENT:


